Pawsitively 4 Pink to Hold Golf Tournament June 12

Low-income women in Worcester County to benefit from the event

WORCESTER, Mass.—May 26, 2021—Pawsitively 4 Pink is holding its 2nd Annual Putting With Paws Golf Tournament to support women with breast cancer on Saturday, June 12, at the Leicester Country Club in Leicester, MA.

The average amount spent on each woman is \$8,000. Pawsitively 4 Pink supports these women regardless of their choice of holistic or traditional treatment; there is no other organization that has this follow-through.

Michelle Power, the founder and CEO of Pawsitively 4 Pink, has been in private practice as a psychotherapist in the Worcester County area for more than 25 years. She said she began Pawsitively 4 Pink "after witnessing several close people in my life struggle with cancer and the emotional and financial stressors, and how these factors compromised their journey back to health, I decided to create an organization that would be impactful in a real way for these women. Every year, Pawsitively 4 Pink tries to reach a greater number of women since Massachusetts has the fourth-largest incidence rate of breast cancer in the country, with Worcester being in the top 20 poorest cities in the United States."

Pawsitively 4 Pink was founded in 2018 to assist low-income women who have been diagnosed with breast cancer in Worcester County with financial assistance and emotional support animals to inspire hope and improve their quality of life.
